From a bunch of other sheep.










Personal consciousness still exists . . . Just as it has always existed — By bare subsistence.

Is too restrictive.














Does a person study better if she wears wool instead of denim? Does a student's ability to learn decrease with the length of his hair?

Wrong.




























Being plastic is what it's all about.

Because they mouth the prescribed answers.


Some are "bad students"
